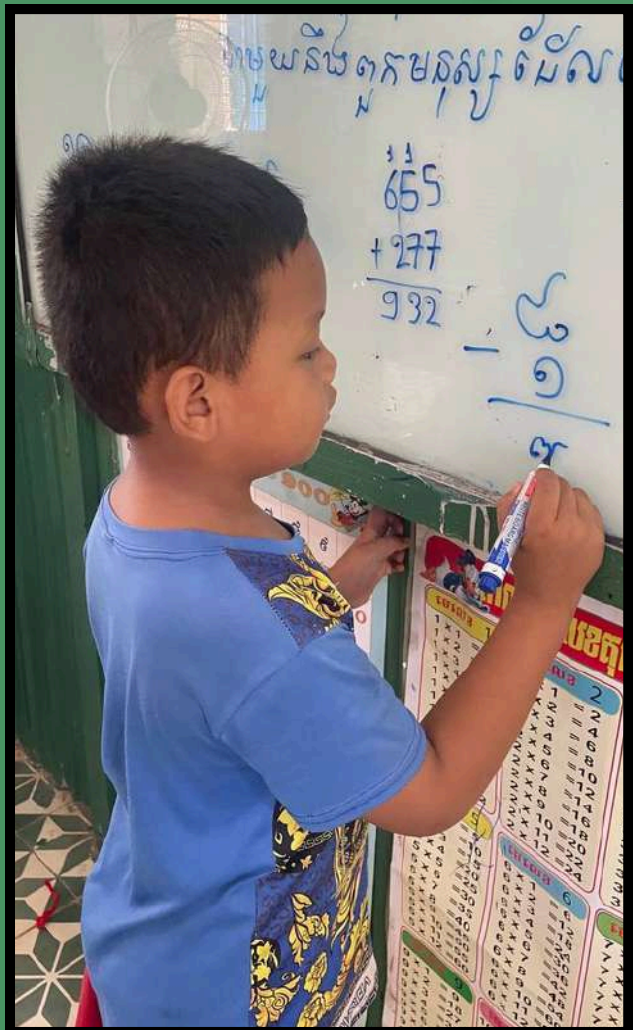
HCD AND ICARE PROGRAM
